

ClinEdAus Project Plan 2020

Introduction

ClinEdAus was launched in December 2014 through funding from Health Workforce Australia, the Queensland Department of Health, and its ongoing review is supported through funding from Queensland Health. It is an open access, no user cost, evidence-based one stop shop website for learning support and training materials for allied health clinical educators.

ClinEdAus is intended to support the delivery of more health professionals into the workforce through greater clinical educator capability, improved knowledge and efficiencies, and improved quality of clinical education.

Vision

Supporting high quality clinical placement experiences for allied health students

Mission

To provide a repository for contemporary, high quality, evidence based clinical education resources which support clinical education across health professions.

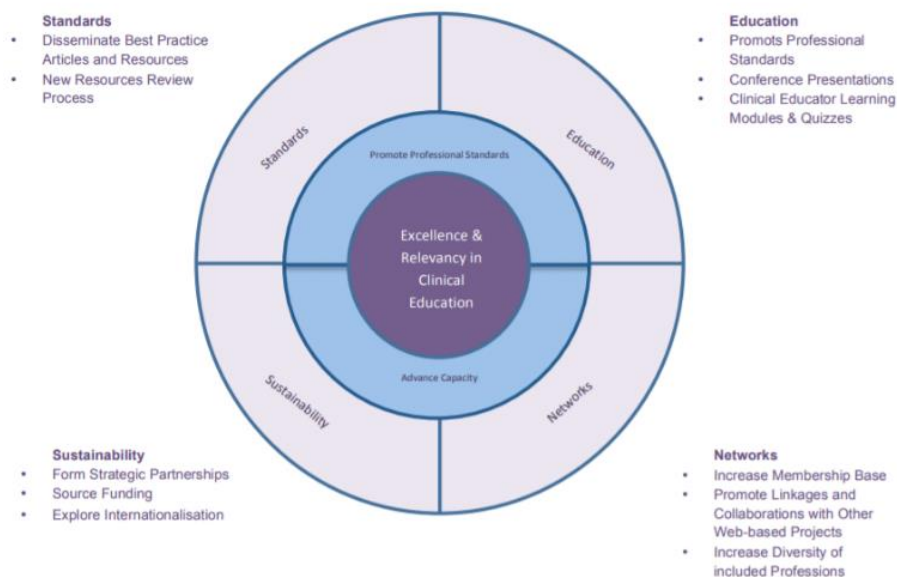


Figure 1: Achieving our mission

This will be achieved by progressing work in four key areas of standards, education, sustainability and networks (Fig 1)
