

# **OT Clinical Educator Tips**

## Post Placement: Clinical Educator Reflection

You may find it useful to reflect on your experiences of being a clinical educator at the conclusion of the placement. Consider reflecting on topics from some of the tip sheets to evaluate your contribution. For example, how did you provide feedback, guide clinical reasoning, deal with a difficult situation, find evidence for the student evaluation or promote a positive learning environment? You might choose to discuss your reflections with your own supervisor.

### A framework for reflecting on the placement experience could include

1. Description: What happened?

### 2. Feelings: What were you thinking and feeling?

3. Evaluation: what was good about the experience? What was not so good about the experience?

4. Conclusion and Action plan: what could you have done? If it arose again what would you do?
